

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT OF THE COUNTY OF BROWN, BROWN COUNTY, TEXAS, FORMALLY OPPOSING THE PROPOSED DINOSAUR-LONGSHORE 765 KV POWERLINE AS PROPOSED BY ONCOR CORPORTION, AND DECLARING THE POTENTIAL ADVERSE IMPACTS UPON THE COUNTY OF BROWN, TEXAS.

WHEREAS, Oncor Corporation has publicly declared that it is seeking approval from the Public Utilities Commission of Texas to construct the Dinosaur-Longshore 765 kV Powerline, the proposed Brown County route of which would cross privately and publicly owned land and various geographic and infrastructure resources within the County of Brown, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the County of Brown would be materially affected by the construction of this powerline and otherwise adversely impacted by the proposed routes; and


WHEREAS, Oncor Corporation has made no effort to share detailed project plans with the County of Brown, nor has it considered the substantial physical, environmental and economic impacts that this powerline would cause to property and the residence of Brown County; and

WHEREAS, the County of Brown has a vested oversight responsibility to protect public property, capital improvements, and community resources from harm or uncompensated damage;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT OF THE COUNTY OF BROWN, BROWNWOOD, TEXAS
